



Uniform Policy

2026-2027



Calibre Academy is a uniform school.

If a student arrives out of uniform, parents will be contacted. If appropriate clothing cannot be brought to school, the student will be required to wear clothing provided by the school and change in the Health Aide's office. Loaned clothing must be washed and returned promptly.

All Students

Shirts

- Calibre polo only (navy blue, rich red, or gusty grey with logo)
- Undershirts must be tucked in and not visible
- Spirit shirts allowed Fridays only

Bottoms (Girls & Boys)

- Navy, khaki, or blue jeans allowed (no rips/tears)
- Must be school-appropriate and properly fitted

Shoes & Socks

- Shoes and socks must be worn daily
- Tennis shoes required on PE days
- No flip flops, Crocs, slippers, or open-toed shoes



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**All students must be in dress code to attend class.
Parents and students are responsible for compliance.**



Girls (K–8)

May wear:

- Navy, khaki, or blue jeans (no rips/tears)
- Pants, shorts, capris, skorts, or jumpers
- Jumpers with white Peter Pan collar or Calibre polo

Additional rules:

- Shorts must be worn under jumpers
- Skirt/short length must reach middle fingertip
- Leggings/jeggings not allowed (even dress-down days)
- Sweatpants allowed only on dress-down days (not house days)
- No short or skin-tight shorts or skirts may be worn. Shorts, skirts, and dresses must meet the school's length requirements. Leggings or tights worn underneath do not exempt a student from this requirement. Clothing with intentional tears, rips, holes, or cuts, including those in pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses, is not permitted, even if leggings or tights are worn underneath

Boys (K–8)

May wear:

- Navy, khaki, or blue jeans (no rips/tears)
- Pants or shorts with Calibre polo
- Pants must be worn at the waist

Additional rules:

- Tennis shoes required on PE days
- Sweatpants allowed only on dress-down days
- Pajama bottoms are never allowed



Other Guidelines

- Hair must be clean, neat, and school-appropriate
- No Heely's
- Hats not allowed indoors or during the Pledge of Allegiance
- Hoodies, hats, beanies, and bandanas may not be worn inside. *Sweaters/jackets must be removed when outdoor temps are 90°+
- Dress-down days still require modest, school-appropriate clothing
- Pajama bottoms are never allowed
- House days: house-color shirt with uniform bottoms
- When there is a "wear your own clothes day" (students may wear their own clothes on their birthdays) clothing must be neat, proper fitting, and school appropriate. No intentional or "stylish" tears or cuts should be found on pants or tops.
