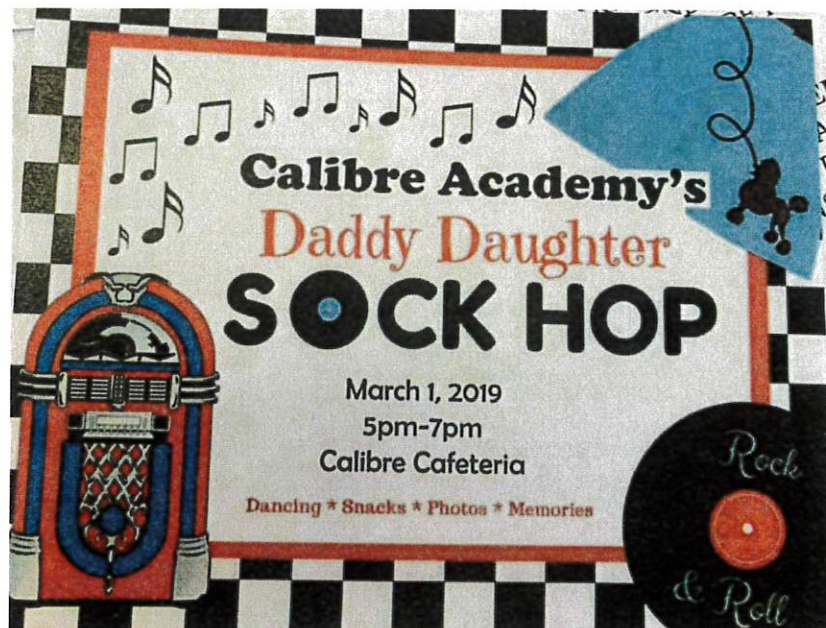


Student Council
