RSVP: April 12th (in order to order shirt and bow no registrations will be taken after this date)

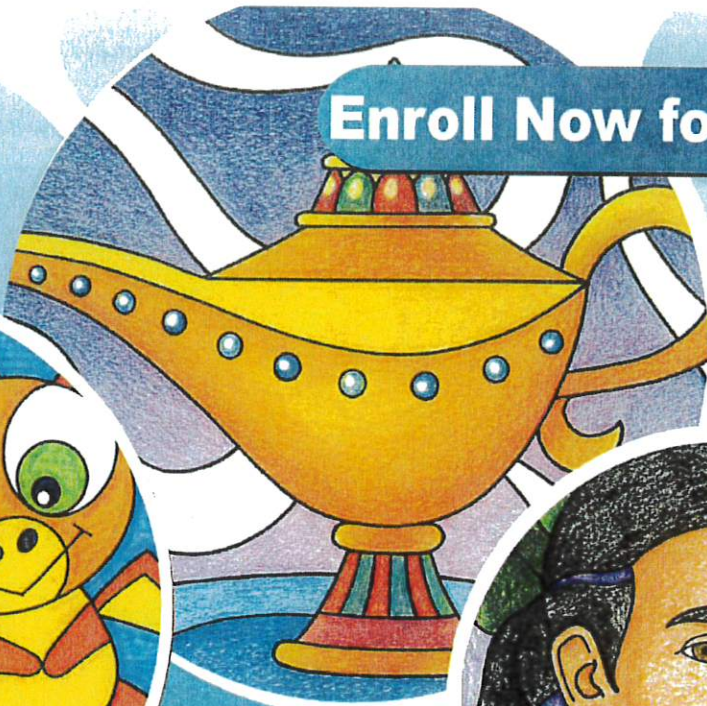

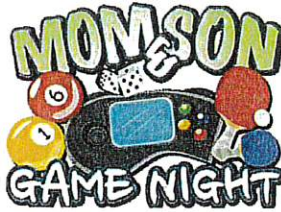

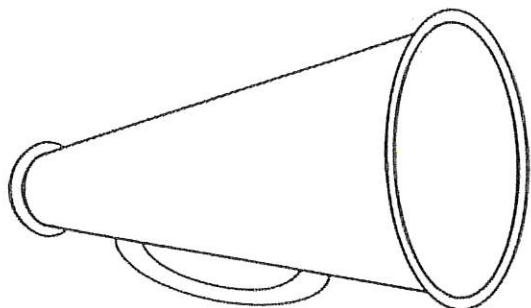
