Child - "Because I don't like them."

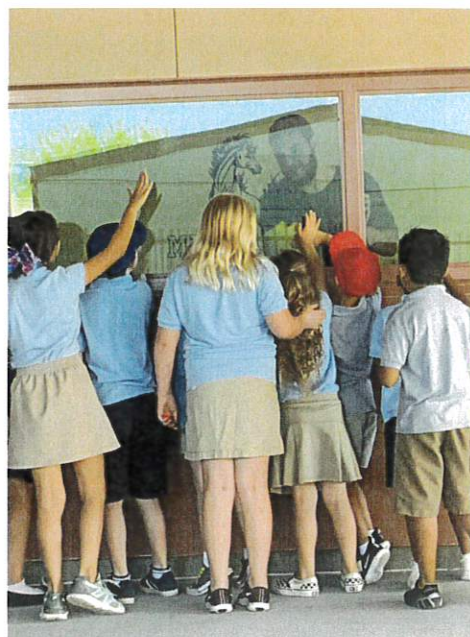
Child - "I can't find my water bottle"

The children teach us something new every day in Extended Care & we could not be happier!

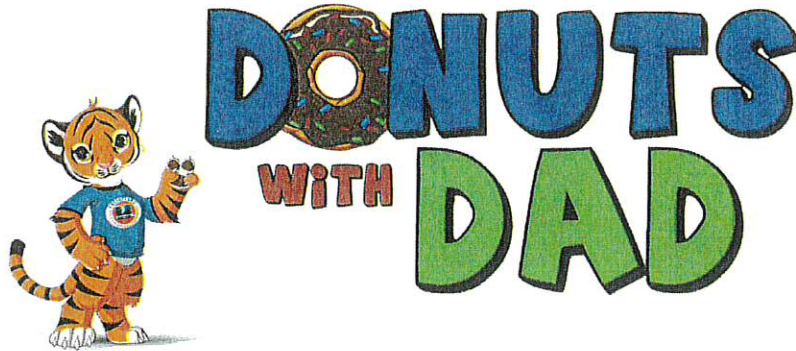
