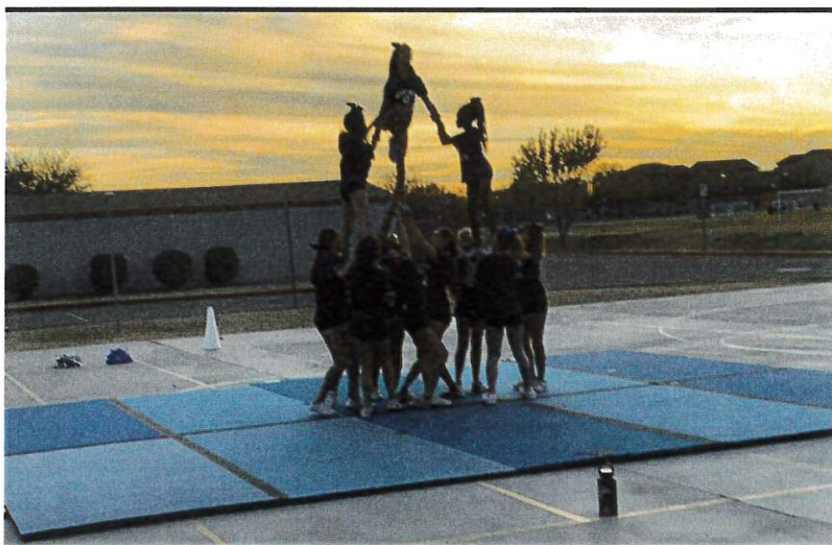

Dec. 6th – Kinder & 1st grade

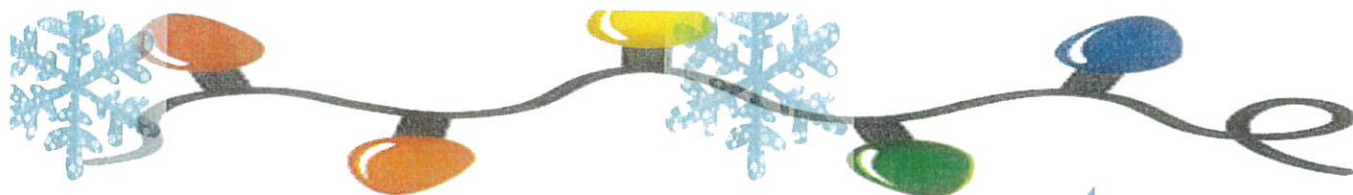
