### **News from the Office**

#### **MID-YEAR REMINDERS**

Cannot believe that we are already halfway through the school year! We would like to remind parents of a few things:

If your child has a cell phone and brings it to school, please have them turn it off before they enter the gate in the morning and it cannot be turned on until after they leave the gate in the afternoon. If you need to get a message to your child, please call the office and they will get in touch with the teacher.

If you need to pick your child up early from school, please make sure you do so by 2:00pm. A parent will need to be in the front office before a student is called out of class to leave. You can email the teacher to let them know they will be leaving early, but the teacher will not send them to the office until the office calls for the student.

If you child is absent, please make sure you call the attendance line at 623-201-2502 or the school's main number at 623-556-2179, press option 1. (An email to the teacher letting them know the student will be out is not the same as calling the attendance line.)

The speed limit in the parking lot is 5mph and it is against the law to be on your cell phone (hands-free only). When dropping your child off, please stay to the right and have them get out on the passenger side. If you would like to walk with your child to the gate, please park and walk to the gate. (Make sure you use a crosswalk.) At dismissal, please stay to the right and pull forward all the way to the front if possible, (but please do not stop in a crosswalk) this way the line does not back up too long. Teachers will walk to the canopy shaded area to meet you and let your child get into the vehicle from the passenger side. If you want to get out of your vehicle, please park in a parking spot.



### South Parking Lot Rules for Drop-off and Pick-up

Safety is our first priority when it comes to pick-up and drop-off of the students. This is a reminder of the rules for drop-off and pick-up of students in the south parking lot behind the school. These rules are for the care and safety of all students, no matter their age.

- 1. Gates open up at 7:45am. If you are dropping off students prior to that time, please note that they will not be supervised by our staff. Remind them that playing in the road is prohibited and make sure that they take their trash with them when they go inside the school.
- 2. Please refrain from using your phones while driving on campus. In the moment you look down, someone or thing can be in front of your vehicle.
- 3. The speed limit in the parking lot is 5 miles per hour, even when you are running late.
- 4. There are two lanes when you turn to into the parking lot. One (right/East) is for curbside pickup and drop off only. The second (left/West) is for parking in the lot only. If you get into the left lane, do not cut off the driver to the right. Please do not drive down the center of the road.
- 5. Curbside pick-up/drop-off is for quick entry or exit from the vehicle. Parents are **NOT** to get out of their vehicle to help the child. If you want to get out of your vehicle, please park in the lot and walk to the gate or awning.
- 6. Curbside, please pull all the way forward past the awning. Do NOT stop short near the gate or in the crosswalk,
- Curbside, make sure students are exiting and entering the vehicle on the curb/passenger side only. Students need to stay out of the street.
- 8. Please make sure you are using the crosswalks when you are walking from the lot to the curb. Do <u>not</u> walk at a diagonal from the crosswalk to the gate. Not only is this not safe for you or your child, this also causes a backup to traffic. Our children learn from us.
- 9. If traffic is stopping, please do not block the crosswalks. Stop prior to them.
- 10. Please watch the crossing guard's for directions. They are there for the safety of the children and to keep the traffic flowing.
- 11. If you are standing at the gate, please stand closer to the gate or on the sidewalk and not in the road.
- 12. Placards are required all year for pick-up. If you are curb side, you can place them on your dash for faster service.
- 13. Students will be outside for pick-up for 15 minutes after their dismissal time (2:30 Kinder, 2:45 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> and 3:00 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>). After, they will be in the front office and you must park in the lot in the front of the school and come into the office to pick them up. You will be required to show id in the office, not the car placard.
- 14. Please do not drive over the cones!
- 15. There is only one way into the parking lot and two lanes that exit the lot. Please do not drive down the center lane to enter. That lane is an exit only lane.
- 16. Please make sure that **EVERYONE** that is picking up and dropping off knows the rules. If you need extra copies of this form, let the front office know and we will happily email or send one home with your student.
