

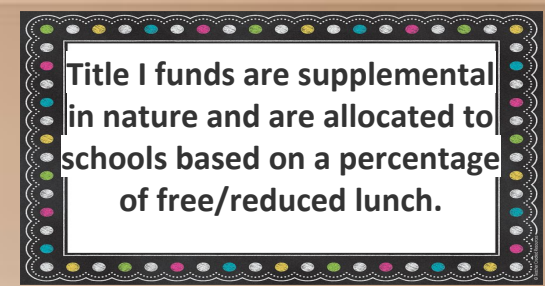

Schools that receive Title I funds can develop and implement supports and interventions that supplement the regular instructional program of the school. struggling students.

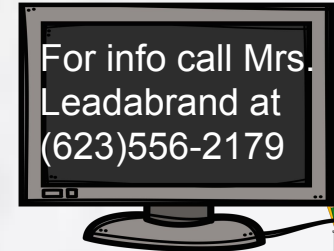
The needs of students who are struggling in the regular education environment may be addressed with strategies, such as additional instructional time, smaller group or individual instruction, or alternate instructional approaches.

At a Glance
MTSS (Multi-tiered System of Support)
is a framework to provide targeted
support to struggling students.
It screens and monitors all students.
The goal of MTSS is to intervene early so
students can catch up with their peers.
There are three tiers - tier 1 is whole
class; tier 2 is small group; tier 3 is
intense intervention.
